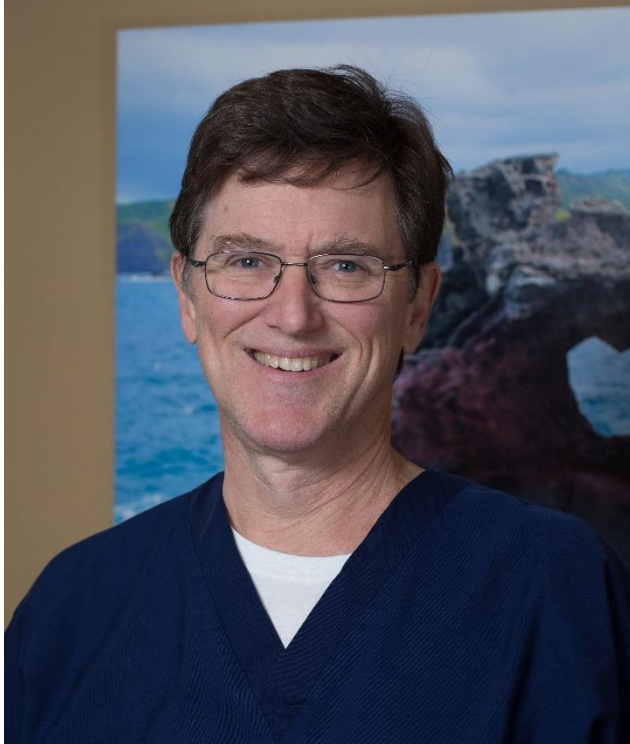


Vein Center of New Mexico Earns Accreditation from National Organization

Albuquerque's Vein Center of New Mexico has earned their second accreditation from the national Intersocietal Accreditation Commission (IAC) in Superficial Venous Treatment and Management. This latest accreditation demonstrates the facility's ongoing commitment to providing quality patient care in vein treatment and management.

Vein Center of New Mexico medical director and owner, Michael Harding, M.D. received notice of the award in November 2017. IAC accreditation is a “seal of approval” that patients can rely on as an indicator of consistent quality care and a dedication to continuous improvement. The award considers the training and experience of the vein specialist performing the procedure, the type of equipment used and the quality assessment metrics each facility is required to measure, all contribute to a positive patient outcome.

The center has earned Vascular Testing Accreditation in 2012, 2015, and 2018. The center overall received accreditation in 2014 and 2017.

To earn the accreditation the Vein Center of New Mexico passed an intensive application and review process including patient case studies and was found to comply with published medical standards for quality patient care in vein treatment and management by a panel of medical experts. IAC accreditation reviews multiple areas of medicine including phlebology, vascular surgery, vascular medicine and more.
